Legitimate Interest Assessment

Identifying our Legitimate Interests

The objects of our organisation include “ to advance education and in particular the education of people in their Third Age”. We do this by offering membership of our organisation. It is in our legitimate interest to collect and store personal information from our members in order to provide the services associated with this membership. These services include:-

- The administration of membership
- To tell members about the activities they can take part in
- To inform members generally about the activities of our U3A and the wider U3A movement
- To provide notice of our AGM
- Provide course leaders with individual member’s contact details for the purposes of inviting them to join this leader’s course.

Balancing our Interest with the Rights and Interests of the individual

We believe members expect us to use their data in the way described above when they join our organisation.

In our Privacy Policy we explain how we use their data and we provide them with a way of objecting if they wish.

Each time we communicate with members we provide an easy way for them to exclude themselves from future communications.
